Additional opportunities include the Young Handler Seminar and, for the

younger equestrian set, the Dressage Explorers program, taking place October 2, will offer educational games, a scavenger hunt, a meet-and-greet with the Tempel Lipizzans.

Also on Sunday, the Delaware Valley Combined Training Association will perform with a 12-horse “quadrille,” showing off extensive training of horses and riders.
